

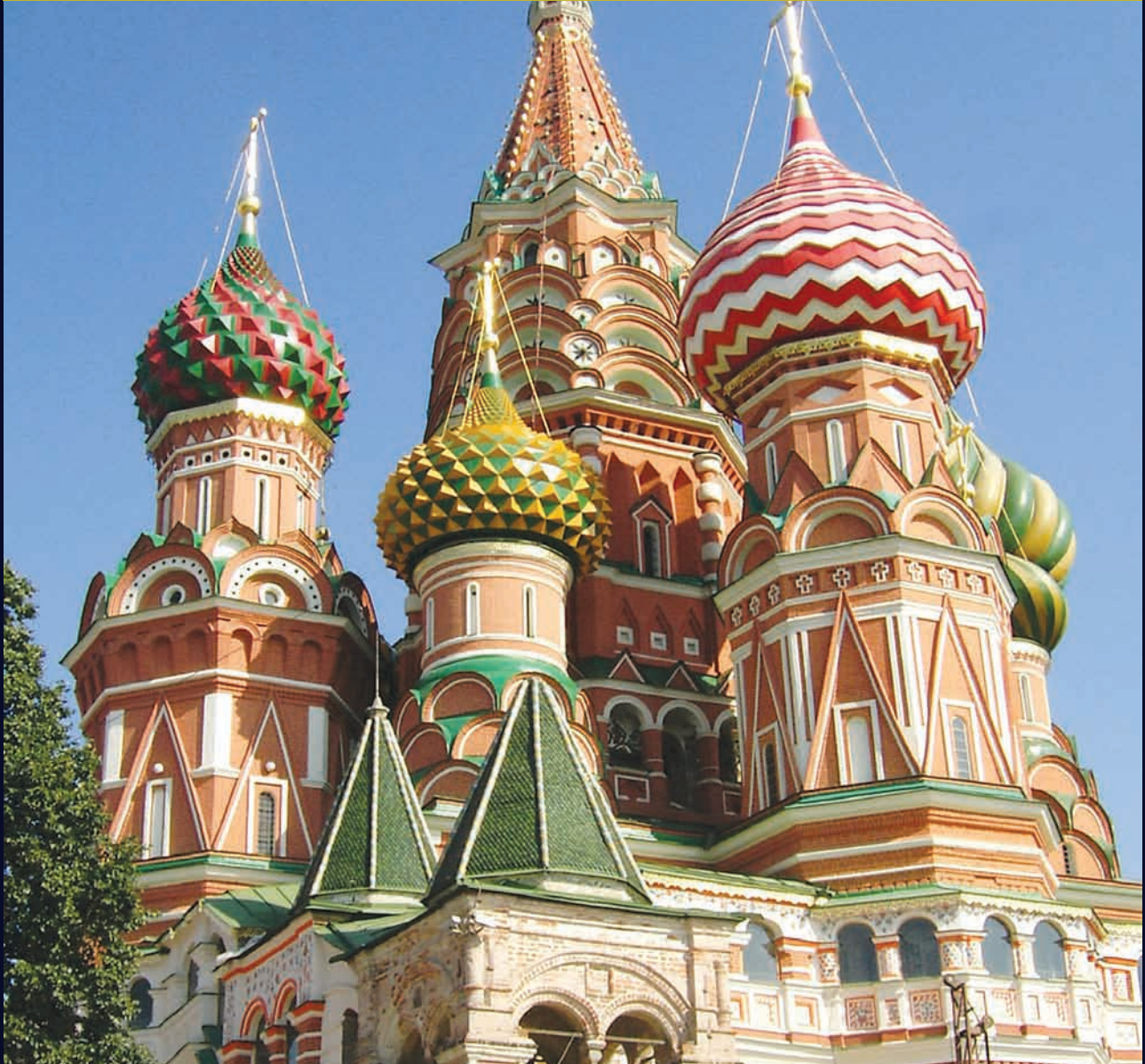

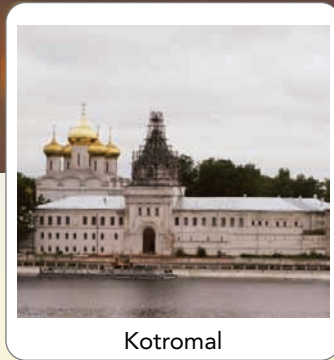

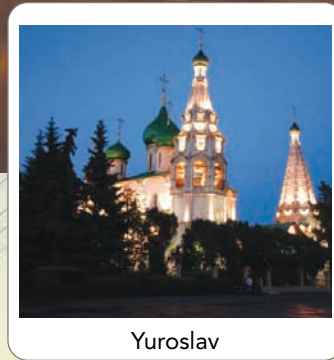

RUSSIAN WATERWAYS

14 Days - Enjoy a Grand Cruise from Moscow to St. Petersburg

Enjoy a spectacular voyage through the heart of Russia along its colorful and historic waterways.

Explore bustling and excitement-packed Moscow, then cruise north and visit the enchanting Golden Ring cities of Uglich, Kostroma and Yaroslavl.

Continue along the Volga-Baltic Waterways and through Europe's two largest lakes, Onega and Ladoga to St. Petersburg, one of the world's most beautiful cities, spread over 101 islands and 66 canals.

Day 1 (JUN 11) THU DEPART TORONTO

Board your overnight flight to Moscow, Russia.
Transportation: Air Canada / Lufthansa Airlines

Day 2 (JUN 12) FRI ARRIVE IN MOSCOW, RUSSIA (D)

Arrive in Moscow and embark the ship. Relax in your stateroom or explore the city before meeting your fellow travelers at the Welcome Cocktail Reception.

Day 3 (JUN 13) SAT MOSCOW (B,L,D)

After breakfast, visit Russia's beautiful capital city, founded in 1147. See the Red Square, the St. Basil cathedral, the Lenin Hills, the Tverskaya, the Lubyanka Square (KGB building) and Arbat Street. After lunch take a ride on the Moscow metro, and then take a motorcoach to visit the Tretyakov Art Museum.

Day 4 (JUN 14) SUN MOSCOW (B,L,D)

Your tour within the walls of the Kremlin introduces you to the former royal residence of the Czars and main-center of the Russian Orthodox faith. Visit Russia's oldest museum, the Armory Museum, which houses the former royal collection of treasures, including jewels, crowns, armor, royal carriages, and the world famous Fabergé Eggs. In the afternoon you will proceed to a circus performance in Moscow (date is subject to change). Before dinner join your host and rest of your group for a complimentary cocktail reception on the ship.

Day 5 (JUN 15) MON MOSCOW (B,L,D)

Enjoy a full free day to explore the city at your leisure. Perhaps return to the Kremlin for a more comprehensive tour or join an optional excursion or try a traditional bathhouse, which is a deeply entrenched Russian tradition for relaxation.

Day 6 (JUN 16) TUE UGLICH (B,L,D)

On the banks of the Volga, Uglich was founded by merchants, in 1148. Admire some of Russia's most beautiful churches and cathedrals during your city tour. This includes the Transfiguration Cathedral and the magnificent Church of Dimitry on the Blood, with its tragic story of dedication to Ivan the Terrible's son.



St. Petersburg

Day 7 (JUN 17) WED YAROSLAVL (B,L,D)

Founded in 1010 by Prince Yaroslav the Wise, it is one of Russia's oldest cities, tracing its roots back to the Vikings. Explore the city's history through its architecture, including the fortified 12th-century Transfiguration Monastery and the Church of Elijah the Prophet, home to many beautiful icons.

Day 8 (JUN 18) THU GORITSY (B,L,D)

Goritsy is a peaceful farming town and a typical Russian village. The tour includes the Monastery of St. Cyril on the White lake and the Museum of Icons. Return to the ship to sail for Kizhi.

Day 9 (JUN 19) FRI KIZHI ISLAND (B,L,D)

Kizhi is situated at the north end of Lake Onega and home to some of the most amazing wooden architecture in Russia. Forever linked to Novgorod the Great, the style of architecture reflects its early introduction to Christianity. In 1764 locals built the Church of Intercession, its towering walls and 22 domes, without the use of a single nail. Your walking tour includes the Museum of Wooden Architecture.

Day 10 (JUN 20) SAT SVIRSTROY (B,L,D)

Svirstroy is 100 miles from St. Petersburg with only a population of 1,000. Enjoy some free time to stroll through this unspoiled Russian village and browse through the irresistible handmade trinkets. This is the best place to do souvenir shopping before reaching St. Petersburg.

Day 11 (JUN 21) SUN ST. PETERSBURG (B,L,D)

One of Russia's former capitals, this city rivals Paris or Venice for its romantic image. Dating from the beginning of the 18th-century it was built to the exact specifications ordered by Peter the Great. The city is home to many museums, galleries, palaces, impres-

sive squares and streets. Your sightseeing tour of this beautiful city shows you Nevsky Prospect, Palace Square, St. Isaac's Cathedral and the battle-cruiser Aurora. After lunch, tour the Hermitage museum, the former Palace of the Czars, which houses the royal art collection with over three million works of art. It is one of the largest and most impressive art museums in the world.

Day 12 (JUN 22) MON ST. PETERSBURG (B,L,D)

Today, tour St. Petersburg's famous and spectacular Imperial Estate - Peterhof Palace. Nestled on the shore of the Gulf of Finland, the palace was built by Peter the Great initially as a resting place en route to the Imperial naval base. But the Czar was quick to recognize the attractiveness of the area and masterminded a vast estate intended to rival the famous gardens of Versailles. In your free time absorb the atmosphere of its vibrant cultural life. Tonight, you will enjoy a concert in St. Petersburg (date is subject to change).

Day 13 (JUN 23) TUE ST. PETERSBURG (B,L,D)

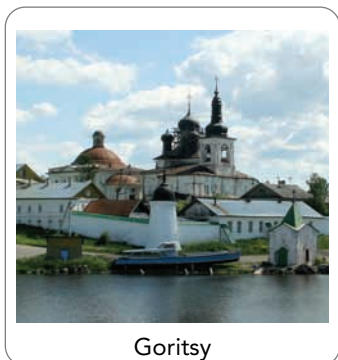
This morning, you will join the excursion to Pushkin and visit the Palace of Catherine the Great (date is subject to change). This evening you are our guest at a Ballet performance at the Hermitage Theatre, the former private theatre of the Czars.

Day 14 (JUN 24) WED ST. PETERSBURG (Disembarkation) - TORONTO (B)

Disembark this morning and transfer to the airport for your home bound flight arriving the same day. *Transportation: Lufthansa Airlines / Air Canada*

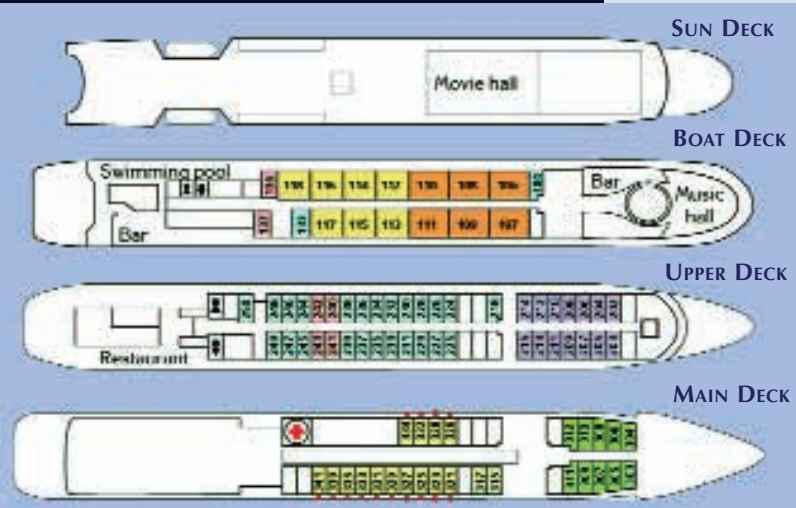

MS TOLSTOY



Named after the famous author Leo Tolstoy, this unique ship is the most luxurious and comfortable cruise ship ever built for Russian rivers. Constructed in Austria using high quality materials and at a much higher cost than other ships, the Tolstoy was designed for high ranking Kremlin officials and to host foreign dignitaries. Today, she is still one of the top ships in Russia, with luxurious decor, well-appointed staterooms, elegant public areas and wide circular stairs. The Tolstoy accommodates 160 guests, versus 200 - 300 on other ships of similar size.

Standard staterooms are 110 square feet - 20% larger than other ships - with large picture windows that open, ample closet space and a makeup table. Bathrooms feature a separate shower area, which is unique for Russian ships. Jr. Suites are 220 square feet with 2 picture windows, a sitting area and two twin beds which can be put together. Spacious suites measure 330 square feet and have 3 picture windows, a dayroom with a TV, a refrigerator, and a separate bedroom. For added space, we store your suitcase for you after you unpack.

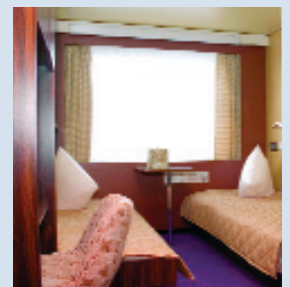
Circular stairway connects all decks

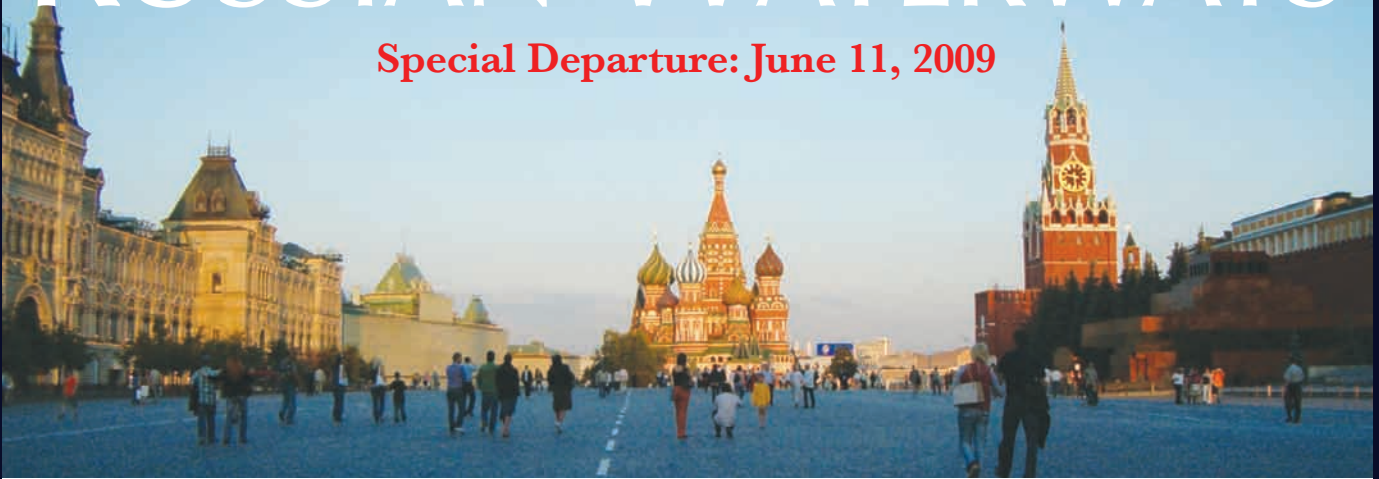

- The air credit for trip from Toronto to Moscow & St. Petersburg to Toronto will be \$950pp.
